In this French homoeopathic Pharmacopeia Georg Heinrich Gottlieb Jahr (January 30, 1801 – July 1875) describes the preparation of remedies and gives in one of the chapters recommendations for the selection of potencies, size of dose, way of administration as well as hints which allow to judge the reactions of the organism and correctly deal with the case.

I constructed a diagram from the text, how to proceed if an aggravation is seen after administering a remedy.

Characteristic symptoms: symptoms characteristic, typical, peculiar to the remedy

Pathognomonic symptoms: symptoms characteristic for this case of disease
